

Life in the UK test

Identification requirements

Acceptable forms of identification for candidates - Original documents only

General identification document rules

- Documents must contain a photograph that is a true likeness of the candidate.
- The document presented on the day of the test to confirm your identity must be the same document you used to register and book the test.
- The details used to book your test must be as stated on the document provided. If you have changed your name you must also provide evidence in Section 2.

Section 1



European Union (EU) Identity Card

This must be in date.



UK photographic driving licence (Full or Provisional)

This must be in date.



Immigration Status Document (ISD), endorsed with a UK Residence Permit (UKRP) bearing a photo of the holder


This may be out of date.

UKRPs are only acceptable when affixed to an Immigration Status Document and not within a Passport.

Candidates in possession of a Passport containing a UKRP should select the Passport option.

An ISD endorsed with a UK Residence Documentation (UKRD)

cannot be accepted





UK Convention travel document (CTD)

This has a blue-cover document and looks similar to a UK passport.


This must be in date.



UK Stateless Persons travel document (SPD)

This has a red cover and looks similar to a UK passport.

This must be in date.



UK Certificate of Identity (CID)

This must be in date.



Section 2

Method of proof to authenticate a last name change

Marriage Certificate

If this document is not in English, it must be accompanied by a certified English translation.



UK Spouse Visa (within date) or on a Biometric Residence Permit (BRP)

Contained within a Passport or on a BRP with the name of the Spouse clearly identifiable to correspond with the details provided by candidate.



Deed Poll Change of Name Document

Must be the official and original document clearly identifiable to correspond with the details provided by candidate.
